Mr. Hinton has proven leadership ability, developed over 15 years spent with The 20th Special Forces Group. As a Sergeant First Class, he was the Senior Weapons Sergeant for ODA 2031 in Operation Enduring Freedom. SFC Hinton was Current Operations NCO at SOCSOUTH and deployed to Haiti and Cuba in support of Operation Secure Tomorrow. Mr Hinton was assigned to work with the DEA for one year helping to develop and implement a Counter-Terror/ Counter- Drug task force for the Dominican Republic. He graduated from Hobart College with a Bachelors degree in English Literature and has excellent verbal and written communication skills. He spent four years as a Manufacturing Supervisor, and directly supervised over 60 employees for a Fortune 50 company. He has also worked as a Private Investigator and Executive Protection Specialist. He has a Spanish Language aptitude rating of 2/3.

Special Forces Weapons Sergeant, Special Forces Engineer Sergeant, Operations NCO/ C/1/20th Special Forces, Special Operations Command South 1989-2005

Sergeant First Class (SFC) Hinton has honorably served for over 15 years in a variety of positions in the USARNG and on active duty Special Forces assignments. SFC Hinton has served in the duty positions of Special Forces Engineer, Special Forces Weapons Sergeant and also as acting NCOIC of Special Operations Command South during Operation Secure Tomorrow, deploying to Haiti and Cuba. He spent a year in the Dominican Republic working with the DEA to develop and implement a Counter-Terrorist and Counter-Drug task force. He has conducted training missions in several Central and South American countries. He was Senior Weapons Sergeant for ODA 2031 during Operation Enduring Freedom and led multiple combat raids. He personally trained and led host nation forces on these missions. He also saw duty and conducted training in Uzbekistan and Kyrgyzstan during OEF.

Operations Manager, SpecOps Inc. 1998- 2000

Mr Hinton conducted site security for special functions, including events sponsored by Michael Bloomberg, current mayor of NYC. He was responsible for the daily operations of a small Private Investigation company. These duties included all facets of investigation, surveillance and documentation of criminal activity. He worked for the District Attorney of New York and several attorneys and insurance companies providing evidence to support criminal fraud and copyright infringement. He also recruited, trained and supervised personnel for site security details.

Executive Protection, American International Security Corporation, 1997-1998

Mr Hinton worked as a site security detail member and was also the shift leader in charge of up to twenty protective detail members. He was also responsible for providing security for corporate executives during travel and while they attended meetings. He was also responsible for recruiting, training and supervising site security personnel.

Senior Manufacturing Supervisor, Carrier Corporation , 1992-1997

Mr Hinton was responsible for the daily manufacturing process of commercial air conditioners. The product built by his employees was the 19XL, which accounted for over 100 million dollars in gross sales revenue annually. He directly supervised over sixty hourly members of The Sheet Metal Workers of America, Local 527. He was involved in screening applicants for employment, training them to build the products and complying with the collective bargaining agreement. During his first eighteen months, output on his line increased from an average of eleven units per week to an average of over forty units per week with no additional manpower added. During this period, he had zero union grievances filed against him.
